

Minute No. 90

On the 24th day of December, 1926, at 10 A. M., the Joint Commission met in the offices of the American Section, El Paso, Texas, at the call of the American Commissioner, for the purpose of directing the Consulting Engineers to place the proper monument marking the boundary line on the international bridge between Eagle Pass, Texas and Piedras Negras, Coahuila. The Commissioners adopted the following resolution: "Instructions are hereby issued to the Consulting Engineers to place the proper monument on the bridge across the Rio Grande between Eagle Pass, Texas and Piedras Negras, Coahuila, for the purpose of marking the boundary line thereon in accordance with Article IV of the Treaty of 1884, on their next trip to the Lower Rio Grande." The meeting was adjourned to meet again at the call of either Commissioner. ---
